AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF COIN OPERATED MUSIC BOXES, JUKE BOXES AND OTHER MECHANICAL MUSIC DEVISES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation by agent or otherwise to operate at any place within the limits of the Village of Clark Fork a coin operated music box, juke box, or other mechanical music devise without having first obtained a license therefor.

Music devise shall be the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per year, which may at the discretion of the Board of Trustees be payable quarterly. Application shall be made to the Board of Trustees for the granting of such license, and upon said license being granted, the Village Clerk shall issue a license to applicant upon a form provided by said Village.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs for such offense,

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Clark Fork, which is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Village for the publication of this ordinance.
