ORDINANCE NO. 124

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.114 OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO, BY AMENDING SECTION 3 OF SAID ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A SMALLER LICENSE FEE FOR THE OPERATION OF PUBLIC CARD TABLES AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No.114 of the Village of Glark Fork, Idaho, shall be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

"Section 3. The license fee to be paid to the Village Clerk shall be Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each card table for the period of three months."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Clark Fork, which is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Village for the publication of this Ordinance.

Passed under suspension of the statutes and rules and duly enacted as an Ordinance of the Village of Clark Fork at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Clark Fork held on the 3rd day of December, 1951.
