## Minutes of the 2/9/26 Clark Fork Regular City Council Meeting

Council President Sharon Banning called the February 9, 2026 Regular Meeting of the City Council to order at 6:00 p.m.

**Pledge of Allegiance:** Council President Banning led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Roll Call of Council Members:** Sharon Banning, Jay White and Tim Yetter were present, constituting a quorum.

#### **Motion to Approve the Consent Agenda:**

#### **New Business:**

##### **A. Discussed, Universal Well Pay Request and Change Order.**

Dan Remmick was present to explain the Universal Well Pay Request amount for \$140,950.00. He explained they had added 37 feet of pipe, but also saved costs by using an existing pump for testing in place of purchasing a test pump.

Council Member Yetter made a motion to approve the Council President signing the Universal Well Pay Request and Change Order. Seconded by Council Member White.

Dan Remmick was present to explain the pay request to La Riviere for \$120,475.41 for the work completed since the last payment. The balance to completion of Phase 2 is now \$310,653.77. Mr. Remmick also mentioned the Phase Three would likely go out to bid in March pending DEQ approval.

Council Member Banning moved to approve Ordinance 291-2, amending Ordinance 291. Council Member White seconded the motion.


