RESOLUTION NO. 2-2026

CITY SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR SERVICES

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, ADOPTING AN UPDATED SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR PROVIDING SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 63-1311 authorizes the City to set and modify fees for services provided by the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforementioned statute, the City has previously adopted fees for various services provided by the City, which fees are contained within other ordinances or resolutions; and

WHEREAS, periodic revisions to currently existing fees, or implementation of new fees, may also be necessary from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 63-1311A requires public notice and a public hearing when establishing new fees or increasing fees by more than 5%; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clark Fork consolidated all fees charged for services provided by the City into a single unified fee schedule, which schedule was contained in City of Clark Fork Resolution 2-2025 as an attached "Exhibit A" to said resolution.

WHEREAS, the City of Clark Fork wishes to now further update fees charged for certain services.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Clark Fork, that the unified fee schedule for the City of Clark Fork be amended, subject to the following:

I. FEE SCHEDULE

That Exhibit A of the City of Clark Fork Resolution 2-2025 is hereby repealed and replaced. Fees for all services provided by the City shall be assessed in those amounts reflected in the attached **Exhibit A** to this Resolution 2-2026.

II. REAFFIRMATION OF CITY FEE RESOLUTION



III. EFFECTIVE DATE



A non-refundable deposit of 10% of the hookup fee is required at the time of application and will be applied to the final invoice for the hookup fee upon full payment. Full payment of the hookup fee will be required before installation begins. **Fire Service Connection Fees for requested lines larger than four inches will be quoted on a case-by-case basis.
